TALK HOMEWORK & WOW WORDS

Each week we send a Talk Homework activity and 'Wow' Words home and we would be very grateful for your support.

We are trying to help all our children develop excellent speaking and listening skills, which in turn will help them with their writing. "If a child can't say a sentence then they can't write it either!"

Please spend at least 10 minutes talking with your child about the questions below;

This week the children found out their new classes. This is always an exciting time and one that creates a lot of discussion in school. What do you think makes the perfect Teacher? If you had to create a recipe that if followed would produce the perfect Teacher what would it include? Talk to your families at home about their Teachers at school. Who do they remember and why? What characteristics do your families think a great Teacher needs and do they have any stories from their school days that they can tell you?

In Big Talk, we use 'WOW' Words to improve our vocabulary and 'big up' our sentences to make them more interesting!
