<u>Topic</u>	<u>Activity Ideas</u>
English	<u>Year 5:</u> Write a book review of a fiction and a non-fiction text
	<u>Year 6:</u> Continue to work through your Revision Guides
	<u>Year 5 and 6:</u> Create an information poster that explains the main word classes ( <i>nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions, determiners etc...</i> )
Maths	<u>Year 5:</u> Practise ordering and comparing fractions and equivalent fractions. Create a set of instructions for each of these.
	<u>Year 5:</u> Continue to practice your formal methods (addition, subtraction, bus-stop division and long/short multiplication). You could make up questions to solve yourself, turn them into word problems or teach someone the methods.
	<u>Year 6:</u> Continue to work through your Revision Guides
Science	Design a boat that would travel quickly in the water. Think about the features needed to reduce the amount of water resistance. Label your design.
	Find 10 materials from around the house and sort them according to their properties. How many ways can you find to compare them?
Geography	Create a monopoly-style board game following the Norfolk coastline. Play it with your family!
	Think about a coastal area you have visited. Draw a picture of it and label its key features.
Art/DT	<u>Year 5:</u> Design a bread that could be used at a party. Create a set of instructions for how to make the bread. Bake the bread at home and take photos of your creations.
	<u>Year 6:</u> Create and make a fairground ride. Take some photos to show us what you've done!
