PRETTY PAPER STRAW TULIP CRAFT

- tulip flower pattern
- paper straws
- paper
- hole punch
- scissors
- glue stick

1. Print off or copy the [tulip flower pattern](#). Cut it out and use it to trace your tulip flower onto coloured paper. Cut out the tulip flower.

2. Accordion fold the flower folding it 4 times. Punch a hole in the centre of the folded flower with your hole punch.

3. Unfold the tulip flower and fit your green paper straw in and out through the holes of the tulip.

4. Cut out two thin leaves from green construction paper. Add glue to the bottom of each leaf and wrap them around the bottom of the paper straw.



Challenge: Can you create any different shapes to create a bouquet of different types of flowers?
